There was discussion about the benefits of having the AVS principal and a kindergarten teacher attend the next meeting as we will be working on more specifics of the program that will be presented to the School Board. Given the proposed school addition/renovation bond, the preschool team will reconvene after elections. If the bond passes, we would need to explore how construction would impact space. If the bond does not pass, we could move forward given our current numbers and space. A March 31st date was set.
